They'll challenge your prejudices, ask for your reactions, consider how teams develop, look at conflict, discuss team roles, gender differences – and a lot more! All stimulate discussion, enable opinions to be shared and help you build an honest view of your own performance in teams back at work. At the end you complete Action Plans detailing simple, common sense changes to make you an even better team player back at work.

Trainer's Role

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- 1 Divide participants into teams.
- 2 Issue each team with a set of the 30 unique cards.
- 3 Observe teams at work.
- 4 Issue Action Plans for completion.
- 5 Lead a Debrief on the key learning points.
