Project Planning

Apply basic project planning principles to the construction of a log cabin within a tight deadline and within a tight budget!

Learning objectives

- demonstrates the importance of a critical path

About the activity

Project Planning is an easy-to-use team activity that tests participants' projectmanagement and planning skills in terms of:

- planning a schedule
- resource allocation (materials & labour)
- cash-flow smoothing
- cost control

Each team represents the management of the Log Cabin Company that designs and constructs wooden holiday homes. Teams must plan, and quote, for the construction of a log cabin. The client is, of course, looking for the cheapest approach but is also concerned about the quality of the plan.

Teams have details of the 7 stages of the project from clearing the land to putting the roof on and landscaping. They have a file of information about the labour required for each phase and the cost and delivery times of materials. Their task is to plan the build within the deadline and within the budget, allowing for contingencies such as rainy days. They have 90 minutes to plan their project and complete a Schedule, an Order Form and a quotation.

Their schedules are entered into the program that identifies the shortcomings of their plans and scores them out of 100. Can the team work together and come up with a feasible plan? The contract is awarded to the highest-scoring team!

Trainer's role (full guidance supplied in Trainer's Notes)

- Introduce the activity to the whole group in plenary using the PowerPoint presentation provided.
- Explain that teams are going to plan a project the construction of a log cabin.
- Issue the Team Folders and allow teams up to 90 minutes planning.
- At the end of the planning phase, collect the Schedules and Order Forms and input the data into the computer program (very straightforward).
- Issue Review Forms for teams to analyse their performance.
- Conduct a debrief, getting teams to give feedback on how they worked together and how they approached the task.
- Issue the final reports and award the contract to the highest scoring team.
- Lead a discussion on the key points and summarise the lessons (supplied on the PowerPoint presentation).
